Description

Early Childhood Education (ECE) Transfer Pathway associate degrees (AS) are accepted at any Minnesota State university that offers a designated early childhood bachelor's degree. The university guarantees that students transfer into the designated bachelor's program with junior status and may complete the bachelor's degree without losing credits or taking extra courses.

A DHS background study will need to be conducted to be able to enroll in ECE 2510 Internship.

Program Student Learning Outcomes

- 1 Explore the physical, social, emotional, language, cognitive, and creative development of young children from birth through age eight
- 2 Demonstrate strategies for developing an appropriate learning environment
- 3 Apply guidance and management techniques to accommodate the developmental characteristics of young children birth through age eight
- 4 Demonstrate the ability to use assessment results to identify needs, learning styles and to plan appropriate programs, environments, learning experiences in order to successfully interact with children, families and the community
- 5 Understand how a child's development influences learning and demonstrate how to plan and implement age and developmentally appropriate learning experiences
- 6 Identify and implement techniques of collaboration with parents, colleagues, children and community services
